**Seeds:** We have a selection of herb, wild flower and salad seeds.

If for any reason you are unable to fit in a visit while in the Highlands, we offer a mail order service from mid May - August.

**Pots:** Selection of garden, patio and windowsill pots - filled or empty.

*Pots can be planted to order but at least one week's notice is required.*

**Garden:** Enjoy walking around or sitting in our small garden all year. In the summer months you can see many of the plants we have for sale, flowering in the display beds. Please note, however, that we are a working nursery and the garden is not an immaculate, formal public park!

*Well behaved dogs are welcome on leads.*

**Surroundings:** The nursery is situated under the dramatic backdrop of Brin Rock, in beautiful Strathnairn, only 7 miles from the A9. The wildness of the landscape is reflected in the garden. We welcome walkers, cyclists, campers, motorhomers, climbers, etc. and if you would like to leave a vehicle in our car park while you pursue your hobby we are happy for you to do so.
